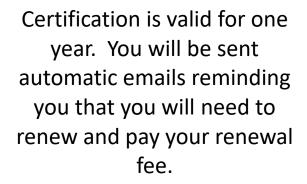

Even if you don't get the emails, you are responsible for renewing your certification before the expiration date.



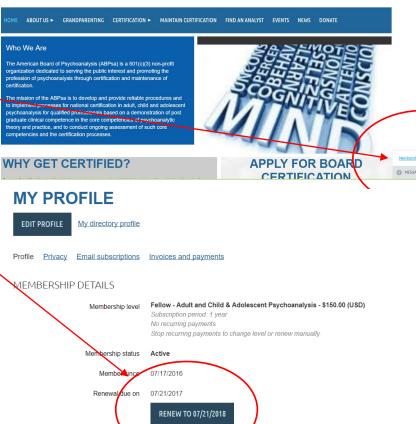
Renewing your certification is quick & easy. This guide will show you how to do it.

How to access renewal

There are two ways to see notification about your renewal <u>once you log in</u>.

- 1) when you log in, you will see notification in the bottom right corner of your web browser.
- 2) when you access your profile, you will see a blue button that says "Renew to (and the next future date)"





Certification (Membership) Renewal

It is important to review and update your profile on a regular basis – the certification renewal is a great time to do this.

If you have any changes to you contact information as well as changes to your practice information be sure to indicate this.

Be sure to also review the Ethics questions and if your response is a yes, you must include an explanation in the box.

Some fields are editable while others are read only. If any of the read only fields have changed, please contact the office.

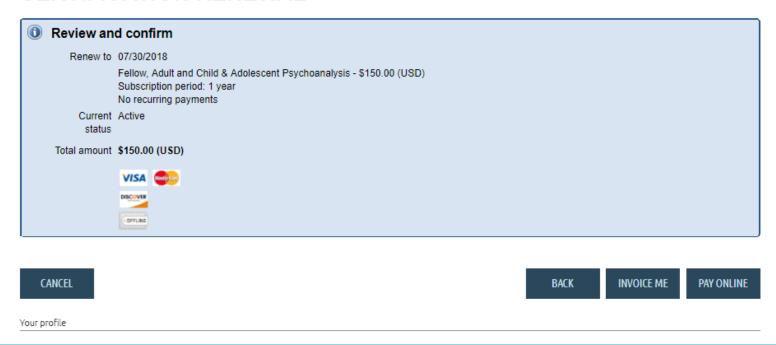

If you click "PAY ONLINE"

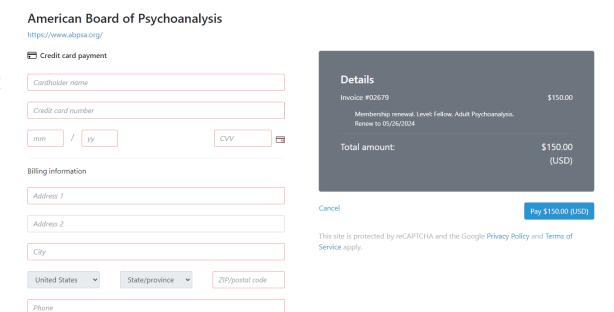
If you clicked "PAY ONLINE", on the next screen you will have the opportunity to enter your credit card details.

Please note that ABPsa does not currently accept American Express.

Once you hit the Pay \$150.00 (USD) button you will receive a confirmation notice if your payment went through or an error notice if you need to reenter any data.

When your payment goes through, you will receive an email informing you that your certification has been renewed for another year.

If you need a copy of your invoice/receipt, you can log in to your profile and view your invoices.



If you click "INVOICE ME"

If you clicked "INVOICE ME", on the next screen you will see the option to view/pay invoice.

If you want to send in a check, you may do so.

Once your check arrives at the ABPsa Board office and is processed, your fee will be posted to your account and you will receive an email notifying you that your certification has been extended for another year.



Paying for your renewal by check

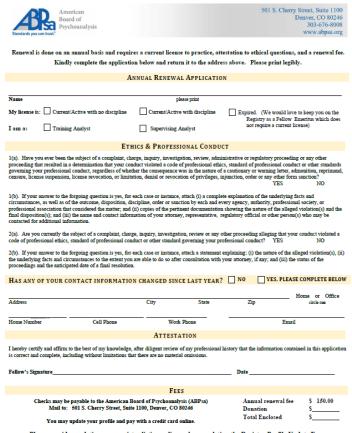
You can pay for your renewal by check or money order.

The check must be made payable to American Board of Psychoanalysis (or ABPsa) and mailed to the office at:

along with your annual renewal form.

Mail is sometimes slow, please allow up to 30 days to receive and process the renewal.



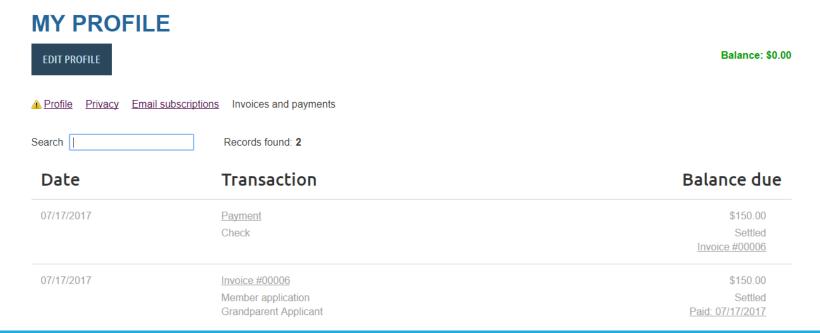

ACCESSING INVOICES

You have access to all your invoices, starting from Fall 2017.

While you are logged in, under your profile, click on the "invoices and payments" link.

Here you will see your invoices and payments.

The website will automatically send you an email confirmation when you submit your renewal payment, in addition to when your renewal application has been approved.

Additionally, before your approval, your profile will state "membership renewal pending". Once approved, this notification will disappear.
